Ordinance Enforcement/ Village Ordinances

If you have a question or concern about any ordinances in place you are welcome to visit the village office during business hours or attend the governance committee meetings and village council meetings.

As a reminder all village ordinances are posted online. If you have a question about a particular ordinance please contact the village office for clarification.

Golf cart owners, please review village ordinance regarding the operation within the village limits (Ordinance Chapter 72. Section 72.08, subsection B.) A child that is at least 12 years of age, but less than 16 years of age shall not operate an ORV on a road or street in the village unless the child is under the direct supervision of an adult, and the child has

immediate possession of a Michigan issued ORV safety certificate or a comparable safety certificate issued under the authority of another state or a province of Canada. The Sheriff's Office has been asked to address underaged operators within the village limits.

Please be mindful to not operate golf carts or other off-road vehicles on village grass or in the parks.

Community Development

The Community Development Committee is viewing all the village properties to map out a plan to best support our needs for the future. This development could be small needs to larger needs. Community Development has a very small budget, therefore we must really pick items that need our attention.

The committee has connected with the Port Sanilac Area Business Association (PSABA) for input. Are you aware of all the wonderful things they are doing for the community? Have you noticed the different flowers on the four corners in the village? That is all because of the PSABA! They also designed a visitors map so visitors can locate their best interest, along with that, they have ads in local magazines. The maps are available in the Port Sanilac Welcome Center located just north of the stop sign on the east side of M-25.

We now have electric blinds in the Bark Shanty Community Center for the voters and movie time for families. We have plans to repaint the signage on the outside of the building.

The DPW built a new deck at the end of Goldman St. for our viewing pleasure. We now have signage with pet requirements at different park areas, plus doggie drop stations. Thank You DPW workers!
