Ex Officio Report: Jim Sroka: Community Development meeting - review properties in the village to suggest uses for the properties that are aligned with the Master Plan. Survey will be mailed out to village residents [and possibly township residents] requesting how parks should be used, and types of activities in each park. Feedback will shared at the town hall in July, 19th at 4PM at the Bark Shanty. This process fits in with the Public Participation process.

Zoning Administrator Report: Larry O'Keefe: Larry covered information regarding the Port Sanilac Wellness and Lofts Brownfield Plan. The planning commission has reviewed the initial plans, final approval pending submission of a land use permit for the project.

Three permits were approved. 1) To construct a home at 7249 Erie St. 2) To construct a patio at 365 S. Lake St. 3) 5 North Lake St. To construct a patio.

 - <u>b</u> New applications 1) 7047 Main St. under new ownership. This property is in the commercial district and is approved as a short term rental
 - <u>c Ordinance review:</u> The council sent the ordinance review of section 17 to the planning commission. An open meeting was held June 19th, at 10AM, at Bark Shanty to review language changes. The updated language was discussed and re-written. This action allowed **Motion** Jim S. 2nd John R to approve the changes as marked. Motion Carried with 1 abstention.

 - <u>d Home inspections</u> The village will require that Martin Inspections will follow an inspection schedule in the order that short term rental applications have been approved by the planning commission.
