The Village of Port Sanilac is blessed to have many Community Volunteers and Benefactors contributing time, financial support and physical gifts to support Village projects and activities. These individuals and groups don't ask for acknowledgement. They support the Village because this is their home; the home of their business, or they have spent time in our community and appreciate what it has to offer, and they want to see the Village flourish.

The following is a partial list of the support the Village has received in terms of contributions, donations and involvement:

The Sanilac District Library donated a Ricoh Copier and eight ink cartridges to the Port Sanilac Municipal Harbor Office

A Community Member donated a LED Display Unit for the Council Room for use in reviewing reports and presentations.

A Community Member wishing to remain anonymous donated \$5,000.00 to purchase repair parts for Fire Hydrants needing repair within the Village.

The Port Sanilac Area Business Association provided Volunteers to collect donations at the Four Corners for the annual Fire Works Display. The Amount Collected: **\$5,541.20.**

The Port Sanilac Blues Festival Fund (Volunteers) have provided many manhours of time organizing, setting up and cleaning up after the Blues Festival. The Blues Festival and it's impact on the community would not be possible without this donation of time and that of others.

The Port Sanilac Garden Club once again supplied the Holiday Wreath displayed at the Village Municipal Offices Building. In addition, they spent considerable time and resources to refresh the garden scape at the Municipal office after the completion of the new ADA ramp.

The Carl and Irene Morath Foundation has provided grants to the Village of Port Sanilac for many Village projects, they include:

- The New Steel Roof for the Gazebo.
- Equipment and manhours to create a new secure storage area for Village documents and records.
- We are currently being considered for a grant to provide a Fixed Electrical Service generator for the Municipal Harbor Office and expect to receive notification regarding same shortly.

2020 Water Project

Engineering has begun for the 2020 Water Project. Surveyors will be in the Village periodically to take measurements and plot the path of 2020 Water and the location of current Water System construction. Initially, Surveyors will work along South Lake Street, Cherry Street, Mulberry and Goldman. Later in the year they will be working in other affected parts of the Village. We will keep you apprised of their movements.

2022 Harbor Park Improvement

The Harbor Park Improvement Project is completed with the exception of the installation of the New Swing Set and the Outdoor Exercise equipment. Supply chain issues delayed its delivery and as a result it will be installed in the spring.

2022 Bark Shanty Project

The Bark Shanty Ventilation project is nearing completion with the exception of the Community Room HVAC equipment. Supply chain issues have delayed it's manufacture and as a result the equipment is expected to be installed upon arrival which is scheduled for January of 2023.

2022 Light House Park Purchase

The Village of Port Sanilac has signed the purchase agreement to acquire the Light House Park from the DNR. Considered to be a surplus asset to the DNR; the Light House Park is integral to a Parks and Recreation initiative undertaken by the Village Council to expand access to Parks and Recreation opportunities within the Village.

Water Bills Are Due Quarterly. Pay on time; Avoid a service shut off. Currently, delinquent water bills total more than \$30,000.00
