VILLAGE OF PORT SANILAC GOOD NEIGHBOR GUIDE FOR RENTERS

Welcome to the Village of Port Sanilac. We are always happy to invite visitors and hope you enjoy your time here. Please visit our website www.portsanilac.net for information on events, restaurants, businesses and more! To make the most of your visit, please remember that you are in a residential neighborhood and some of our residents are required to rise early in the morning. To maintain the peaceful enjoyment our town offers, please follow these guidelines. Failure to do so may result in neighborhood property owners notifying local enforcement officials and could result in a fine. Let's do our best to avoid that!

NOISE: Please respect your neighbors right to the quiet environment of their home. Quiet hours are between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

PARKING: Please utilize the parking available onsite of the property you are renting. Where street parking is available, please engage in good neighbor practices by parking in front of your rental property being mindful not to block sidewalks, mailboxes or driveways.

BEACH USE: There are two public beaches in Port Sanilac. The North Park Beach is located just north of town and east of the Lutheran Church. The Michigan DNR beach and boat launch is located at the north end of Lake Street and requires a daily fee or State of Michigan Recreational pass to park. There are many privately owned properties along Lake Huron. Walking along the beach is permitted in all areas to the high-water mark, but activities such as setting up chairs, blankets and umbrellas are allowed on the public beach areas only.

BONFIRES: Recreational bonfires are allowed on private property but cannot exceed 3 feet in diameter and height. Fires must be attended until fully extinguished and ashes are cold. Emission of smoke/fumes that constitute a nuisance to neighbors is prohibited. Bonfires are not allowed on public property.

TRASH PICK-UP: Garbage shall not be left in public view except in proper containers. Monday is the regularly scheduled garbage and recycling pick up. Please put your trash/recycling out no sooner than Sunday. Emptied garbage and recycling containers should be returned to proper storage as soon after pick-up as possible. Note: When a national holiday falls on a Monday, the pick-up will be held on Tuesday.

PETS: If the owner allows cats and/or dogs, please follow these simple rules. All pets are required to be on leashes whenever they are in an un-enclosed area or on public streets. When walking your dog, you are responsible for picking up and disposing of their waste. Do not allow your pet to trespass on other's property. Remember you are in a residential neighborhood; your pets should not be allowed to make loud & frequent noises that disturb the peace.

GOLF CARTS: Golf cart power vehicles cannot be operated on sidewalks or public land other than village streets. Drivers must be 16 years of age and older and possess a valid driver's license or other state certification as required by village ordinance.

OCCUPANCY: Please follow the occupancy guidelines as permitted by the owner. Check their policies regarding holding events (reunions, parties, weddings, etc.) as there may be restrictions. Remember, large events can have a negative impact on a residential neighborhood due to parking limitations and noise.
